



2025 MNA FEES, FINES AND PENALTY TABLE

Player deregistration cut-off date for partial refund: 30th April 2025. Player must provide written instructions they would like to deregister and include Banks details for partial refund.

Please seek clarification from the MNA committee regarding half/partial season fees (competition specific)

As per MNA By-Law 4.2: All fines must be paid by the offending team prior to taking the court on the next playing date. Offending teams will be penalised any premiership points they receive until the amount owing is paid. Premiership points will not be reinstated

1	Emergency Player Fee (Per Player) Single Game Voucher Team must supply emergency player name, address, contact phone number, email address, DOB, emergency contact name and number to the committee member on duty before taking the court and pay the fee.	\$15	
2	Failure to provide an umpire (By the conclusion of the first quarter of the impacted game)	\$50	Loss of 3 premiership points & Fine.
3	Playing an illegal player.	\$50	Fine & Forfeiture of the match
4	Forfeit after 12pm on fixtured day	\$50	Fine
BEHAVIOUR RELATED Fine/Penalty Maximum recommended penalty for First Offence. (Subsequent offences will be addressed individually to determine consequences)			
1	Contraventions of or other actions regarding the MNA social media Policy	\$250 per individual.	Penalty at the discretion of the Executive committee * which could result in termination of membership.
2	3 x Umpire Warnings over the season (across all competition levels)	\$100	1-3 weeks suspension at the discretion of the Executive Committee
3	1x Umpire suspension	\$100	1-3 weeks suspension at the discretion of the Executive Committee
4	1x ordering off by an umpire	\$100	1-3 weeks suspension at the discretion of the Executive Committee

***Executive committee: The committee will include MNA President and a maximum of 4 additional MNA committee members (including a MPIO when available) Whilst sonority of committee members is considered, a lack of conflict of interest is more pertinent when forming this committee. Their decision will be final.**
